

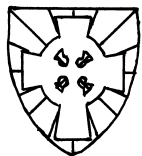

- 1 In 1189 Gerard de Ridefort, grandmaster of the Knights Templar since 1184, is killed in the Siege of Acre.
- 2 In 1187 End of the Siege of Jerusalem: Saladin captures Jerusalem after 88 years of Crusader rule.
- 3 In 1283 Dafydd ap Gruffydd, prince of Gwynedd in Wales, becomes the first person executed by being hanged, drawn and quartered.
- 4 In 1511 Formation of the Holy League of Ferdinand II of Aragon, the Papal States and the Republic of Venice against France.
- 5 In 1143 King Alfonso VII of Leon recognizes Portugal as a Kingdom.
- 6 In 1536, English theologian and scholar William Tyndale, who was the first to translate the Bible into Early Modern English, was executed for heresy.
- 7 In 1513 LA MOTTA (Spanish troops under Ramón de Cardona defeat the Venetians.)
- 8 In 1573 End of the Spanish siege of ALKMAAR, (first Dutch victory in Eighty Years War.)
- 9 In 1003 Leif Erikson lands in L'Anse aux Meadows, Canada, becoming the first known European to reach North America.
- 10 In 1555 The Elector Augustus of Saxony bans firearms. The ban is cheerfully ignored
- 11 In 1347 Death of Louis IV, Holy Roman Emperor
- 12 In 1492 Christopher Columbus lands in the New World
- 13 In 1307 Phillip the Fair orders the arrest of the Templars
- 14 In 1066 HASTINGS (William of Normandy defeats King Harold of England)
- 15 In 1522 Cortes promoted to Captain-General and Governor of New Spain

So You Want to Be Somebody:

How to Choose a Persona

One of the first decisions most people are faced with after joining the SCA is choosing a persona. Don't panic, it's not as hard as it sounds.

The first thing you must decide on is a place and time to be from. Is there a specific historical event, place, or group that is especially interesting to you? Maybe you are interested in the Norman Conquest of England, or the Mongol Invasion, or Italian Renaissance costuming, or the German Reformation, or the Crusades. If so, great! Just decide to be from that place and time. If not, maybe you'll have to dig a little harder.

Think about what activities in the SCA you are most interested in participating in. Wars were fought by armored men with swords and shields from the beginning of our period to its end, and from England to the Far East, so if you want to be a chivalric fighter, I don't guess that helps you narrow it down much.

Want to be a rapier fighter? You probably want to be from Western Europe in the 1400s or 1500s. You won't see many rapier fighters with a 7th century Japanese persona. Want to be an archer? What kind? The best longbowmen came from England and Wales during the 14th and 15th centuries. The best with a recurve bow were the Mongols and Magyars. Crossbowmen from Genoa were employed as mercenaries in many European armies.

Maybe you are more interested in making and wearing fancy clothes. The fanciest clothes came from Western

Europe during the Renaissance. But it depends on your definition of "fancy". It might be a good idea to look through some costuming or art books and find what you like. But remember, just because your persona is from 16th century Florence doesn't mean you can't have an 11th century Viking apron dress.

Once you have determined a time and place to be from, you may, or may not, want to develop your persona a little bit more. There are a few things to remember here. You **CANNOT** be a fairy, elf, or wizard, as these things did not exist in period. Druids were pretty much wiped out by the Romans (pre-period), and witches were often hung or burned at the stake. If you want an esoteric persona, you might consider : herbalist, village wise woman, or alchemist.

The overt practice of religion is prohibited in the SCA, and overtly religious personas are somewhat discouraged. You can be a monk, or a nun, but you cannot do many of the things monks and nuns did. Unless you are a priest or bishop mundanely, you cannot claim to be one in the SCA, nor may you wear the garments generally reserved for priests and bishops, such as stole, chasuble, cope, and miter. Presumably this applies to leaders of other faiths as well.

One final note on personas. I know that many early period peoples were not what we would call "refined". Vikings, Mongols, even Picts, Celts, and Early Anglo-Saxons, came from rather primitive cultures, and tended to behave rather crudely, by more recent standards. Taking on a persona from one of these cultures is not a license to behave in a socially unacceptable manner. Remember that we are all presumed to be from the nobility class, Lords and Ladies, or at least worthy to be Lords and Ladies, and act like it. If you want to be a Viking or a Mongol, by all means do so, but please be a Viking or Mongol with manners.
