The Shadow Reader

By Lord Pædric OMullan

Title – Queen Of Swords Author – Judith Tarr Publisher – Tom Doherty Associates, 1997

Queen of Swords tells the story of Melisende, Queen of Jerusalem. Melisande was the eldest daughter of Baldwin II, third King of the Frankish Kingdom of Jerusalem. Baldwin II had no sons, and law and custom prohibited a queen from reigning in her own right, so Melisende was married off to Fulk of Anjou, who became king upon Baldwin's death. Melisende bore Fulk two sons, Baldwin and Amoury. When King Fulk died in a hunting accident Melisende became regent during the early years of Baldwin III's reign, a position of power she would hold for several years, and would not willingly give up, even as her son came of age.

I found this to be a very well-written and entertaining book, full of battles between the Christians and Muslims, long marches through the desert, and court intrigues. The characters are interesting and believable, and the story moves along at a rapid pace, spanning more than twenty-five years.

I am not an expert on the years of the Crusades, but based on other sources I have read, and according to her own author's note at the end of the book, Judith Tarr followed the course of history closely, and introduced only a few fictional characters to her tale.

Judith Tarr has written several other books as well, mostly about ancient Egypt and about Conquest and Norman England. The books about England have a strong theme of magic, and would therefore be categorized as historical fantasy rather than historical fiction, but I enjoyed reading them and would recommend them to anyone who likes these genres.

Applications Being Taken for Office of Orbis Herald

Orbis Herald serves the Southern Region of Ansteorra, supervising the efforts of all branch heralds and seeing to the heraldic needs of anyone who doesn't have one. The position is largely administrative. Orbis receives monthly reports from branch heralds and sends quarterly reports to Star Principal Herald, accepts heraldic submissions from gentles living in crown lands and in branches without branch heralds, and assists with the resolution of any issues related to heraldry that might arise within the region. Orbis also appoints new branch heralds as necessary, is expected to arrange one regional consultation table per quarter, and is responsible for ensuring that heraldic education happens across the region. More details about the position can be found in Part III.A of the Kingdom of Ansteorra Administrative Handbook for Heralds (online at

http://heraldry.ansteorra.org/docs/COH_Admin_Handbook.pdf)

The current Orbis Herald will complete her term of service at the end of May. Applications for the position are being accepted by Star Principal Herald through April 30th.
