

This Month in the Middle Ages — October

- 1. Papal Legates arrive in England to discuss the divorce of Henry VIII, King of England, from Catherine of Aragon
- 2. In 1491 Ferdinand and Isabella, King and Queen of Castile-Aragon, lay siege to the Moors of Granada, and found Santa Fe, Spain
- 3. In 1468 Louis XI, King of France, strangles several birds, gifts of Charles "the Bold," Duke of Burgundy
- 4. In 1209 Otto IV crowned Holy Roman Emperor.
- 5. In 1553 First Parliament of (Bloody) Mary Tudor, Queen of England convened
- 6. In 1595 A request is made from Hertfordshire for replacement of longbows by muskets, as their bows were unserviceable
- 7. In 1290 William Fraser, Bishop of St. Andrews, suggests to Edward I, King of England, that John Baliol be King of Scots, under Edward
- 8. In 1361 A Trial by Combat between the Chevalier Macaire and a dog. Victory was to the dog, who thus solved the murder of it's master, M. Aubrey de Montidier
- 9. In 1192 Richard I, King of England, begins his return from the 3rd Crusade
- 10. In 1227 Martyrdom of St. Daniel and his companions
- 11. In 1586 Trial of Mary, Queen of Scots
- 12. In 1492 Christopher Columbus lands in the New World
- 13. In 1307 Phillip the Fair orders the arrest of the Templars
- 14. In 1066 HASTINGS (William of Normandy defeats King Harold of England)
- 15. In 1106 Philip I, King of France, and Bertrada, his wife, visited Fulk of Anjou, her husband

- 16. In 1443 An unsuccessful attempt was made to usurp the Japanese Throne
- 17. In 1448, Second Battle of Kosovo, where the mainly Hungarian army led by John Hunyadi is defeated by an Ottoman army led by Sultan Murad II.
- 18. 1599 Michael the Brave, Prince of Wallachia, defeats the Army of Andrew Bathory in the Battle of Şelimbăr, leading to the first recorded unification of the Romanian people.
- 19. 1453 The French recapture of Bordeaux brings the Hundred Years' War to a close, with the English retaining only Calais on French soil.
- 20. In 1536 The "Pilgrimage of Grace" captures Pontefract Castle, England
- 21. In 1521 Henry VIII, King of England, named "Defender of the Faith" by the Pope
- 22. In 1383, the 1383-1385 Crisis in Portugal: King Fernando dies without a male heir to the Portuguese throne, sparking a period of civil war and disorder.
- 23. In 1096 Defeat of Alfonso VI, King of Leon, by Yusuf ibn Tashufin
- 24. In 1260, the spectacular Cathedral of Chartres is dedicated in the presence of King Louis IX of France
- 25. In 1415 AGINCOURT (defeat of France by Henry V of England)
- 26. In 1369 Charles V "the Wise," King of France, dedicates a monument to his personal chef, for a recipe for pickled fish
- 27. In 1524, Italian Wars: The French troops lay siege to Pavia.
- 28. In 1232 Death of Randolph de Blondevile, Earl of Chester (mentioned in "Piers Plowman")
- 29. In 1390 First trial for witchcraft in Paris.
- 30. In 1485 Henry VII of England is crowned.
- 31.In 1517 Martin Luther pins his 95 Theses to the door of Wittenberg Castle church.
