The Shadow Reader **By Lord Pædric OMullan**

Title - *The Crown*

Author – Nancy Bilyeau

Publisher – Touchstone

The Crown is a novel of mystery and adventure. Set during the reign of King Henry VIII, and taking place against the backdrop of the dissolution of the monasteries, *The Crown* tells the story of a novice nun and her search for one of England's greatest relics, the Crown of King Athelstan.

Joanna Stafford is the only daughter of a minor branch of the Stafford family, one of England's great noble families, but one which is very much out of favor with King Henry VIII. Further complicating matters, her mother is Spanish, and came to England in the entourage of Catherine of Aragon. Fulfilling a promise made to Queen Catherine (or the Princess Dowager, if you prefer) on her deathbed, Joanna is also a novice at Dartford Priory, the only Dominican nunnery in England.

Sister Joanna finds herself locked in the Tower of London, arrested along with her father for interfering with the execution of her cousin, the wife of one of the leaders of the Pilgrimage of Grace (or the Northern Revolt, if you prefer.) The only way Sister Joana can escape the Tower alive, and save her father, is to undertake a mission for the wily Bishop Gardiner of Winchester.

The mission: find the Crown of King Athelstan, worn by that mighty Saxon king in the Battle of Brunanburh, at which Athelstan's army overcame overwhelming odds to win a victory which finally, and permanently, united all the Anglo-Saxon kingdoms into one, the Kingdom of England. According to legend, Athelstan's crown will make the rightful king invincible, but will bring death to the unworthy man who touches it. According to Bishop Gardiner, it has already

brought about the deaths of Richard the Lionheart, Edward, the Black Prince, son of Edward III, and Arthur, eldest son of Henry VII.

Bishop Gardiner believes that the Crown is hidden at Dartford Priory, but he doesn't know where. So he has contrived to send Sister Joanna and two Dominican monks from a dissolved friary to Dartford to search for it. While there, they encounter murder, rape, and suicide, and find clues which will lead them to Malmesbury Abbey and London in search of the Crown.

The Crown is Nancy Bilyeau's first novel, though it is hard to tell by reading it. Well researched and well written, this is a fascinating and fast-paced novel with many unforeseen twists and turns. It offers an interesting perspective on the dissolution of the monasteries, and other events during the reign of Henry VIII. Included is an extensive bibliography for those who might be interested in further reading on any of the subjects touched upon in the novel. I thoroughly enjoyed reading *The Crown*, and look forward to future novels by Nancy Bilyeau.
